







Exploring Your Career Choices

<p>Develop a PowerPoint Presentation (minimum of 10 slides) on a career of your choice & present information to the class.</p>	<p>Create a three-fold brochure highlighting a career of your choice.</p> 	<p>Write a children's book on a career, complete with illustrations. Your book must be bound in some manner.</p>
 <p>Interview 3 individuals on the aspects of their careers. You will need to obtain the interview sheets from Your Career Specialist.</p>	<h2 style="font-size: 2em; margin: 0;">JOB SHADOW</h2> <p>a career of your choice a minimum of a ½ day. This project involves setting up your job shadow experience, informing your career specialist of the day you will be going (for attendance purposes) and turning in a verification from when you are finished.</p>	<p>Create a free-standing poster (highlighting a career) that could be used if you were to present at a career fair.</p> 
<p>Make a career board game, highlighting a career or careers.</p> 	 <p>Write a report on a career of your choice. Use MLA format, include cover page and works cited page. You must choose this if you are going to submit Exploratory Career Notebook at MCA</p>	<p>Make a flip chart highlighting all the different aspects of a career of your choice.</p>
