



What: Montana Teenpreneur Challenge

Hosted by: One Montana is a nonprofit, nonpartisan organization based in Bozeman with a mission to create a vibrant Montana by connecting rural and urban communities. *Montana Teenpreneur Challenge* is an offshoot of the organization's highly successful Rural-Urban Student and Entrepreneur Exchange program.

Purpose: *Montana Teenpreneur Challenge* is a statewide contest open to all high school students and designed to celebrate their skills as business developers, real-world problem solvers, and persuasive communicators.

With a purse of \$2,500 in prizes for students with compelling ideas for new products and services and for those who already operate small businesses, One Montana seeks to shine a spotlight on our state's next generation of entrepreneurs.

Teachers and adult sponsors of winning entries will also receive prizes.

A panel of Montana entrepreneurs will select 1st Prize and Honorable Mention in each business category, and all Montanans will have the opportunity to vote for a People's Choice Award.

Dates: October 1-Online contest platform opens, December 1-Contest closes, December 15-Winners announced. Students submitting entries by November 1 will have the opportunity to receive feedback from a team of Montana entrepreneurs and to resubmit a more nuanced entry by the 12/1 deadline.
